

## INPATIENT ADMISSION CRITERIA

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Two basic requirements have to be met to demonstrate medical necessity.

- The services must be reasonable and necessary for the treatment of the patient's condition; and
- It must be reasonable and necessary to furnish the care on an inpatient basis, rather than in a less intensive facility such as a skilled nursing facility, or on an outpatient basis.

## OUTPATIENT ADMISSION CRITERIA

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Patients must require evaluation and / or treatment on an outpatient basis for a physical impairment causing activity limitations and participation restriction.

Prior to admission to outpatient services, patients must be:

- Medically stable
- Able to participate
- Demonstrate rehab potential
- Demonstrate a willingness to participate

Prior to outpatient services, a referral from a physician is required for treatment and follow up care.

## GENESIS VNA - ADMISSION CRITERIA

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1. The Potential Patient and Caregiver's need for services are demonstrated by the Initial Assessment.
2. There must be a licensed physician who will assume responsibility for medical supervision and provide a written plan of care.
3. The physical facilities and equipment in the Potential Patient's home must be adequate for safe and effective care and also provide safe conditions for staff.
4. A responsible caregiver/surrogate decision maker is available and willing to participate in Potential Patient care if person is unsafe by self.
5. The Potential Patient must reside within the geographic service area as defined by the Agency.
6. Initial Assessment results provide a reasonable expectation that the Potential Patient's medical, nursing, social and environmental needs are within the GVNA scope of practice and can be met on an intermittent basis through the provision of GVNA services.

Referrals are accepted from any internal or external source 24 hours per day made by any clinician or other staff member.

Available services include: Nursing, PT, OT, SP, Medical Social Work, Dietician and Home Health Aide.
