- AORN foundation recently funded scientific research proposed by nurses with a \$25K grant for "Investigation of Unplanned Intraoperative Hypothermia Patterns and Relationships in Surgical Patients Warmed with Forced Air: A Secondary Analysis". The purpose is to investigate patterns of unplanned intraop hypothermia and the relationship between number of minutes hypothermic, timing of forced air warming, and surgery type for adult patients that have undergone non-cardiac surgery.

**Old Business:**
